

Parent Quick Start Guide to Twinkl Phonics Minibooks



The Twinkl Phonics minibooks build on skills taught in the Twinkl Phonics Programme. They follow the learning objectives of EYF and EYF-ESF while helping your child to practice and apply their new phonics knowledge to read and write.

Key terms we use in this guide

- Phoneme:** smallest sound that makes up a word (e.g. /t/ and /a/ make up the phonemes in 'cat')
- Grapheme:** letters that represent phonemes (e.g. the phoneme /t/ is written as 't' in a cat or 'tt' in a foot)
- Digraph:** two letters that represent one phoneme (e.g. 'ch', 'sh', 'ai')
- Trigraph:** three letters that represent one phoneme (e.g. 'igh', 'air')
- Adjacent Grapheme:** letters next to each other in a word that make that word sound like one (sometimes difficult to hear separately (e.g. 'n' in 'milk', 'g' in 'spin'))
- Sound Substitution:** when the letters and their order within a word that share the same phonemes are rearranged (e.g. 'cat' - 'act')
- Phonics Knowledge Progression Map:** shows the words that need to be mastered and when they are first introduced. Some of these words can be mastered and some children have heard more words in Level 1 texts.

What Do the Reading Minibooks Look Like?

Each minibook has four that is carefully matched to the stories that your children have learned. In this way, through the Twinkl Phonics Programme, the minibooks give more challenge to match their developing skills.

Level 1

At Level 1, we start with the phonemes /t/ and /a/ to help your child read and write.

They work with 't' to help your child spot how words start with 't' and 'a' to help your child spot how words start with 'a'.

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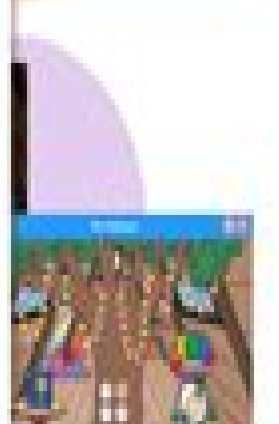
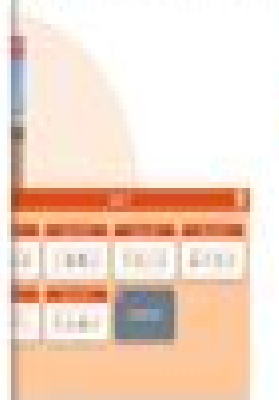
