Country Park And City The Architecture And Life Of Calvert Vaux:

Country, Park and City Francis R. Kowsky, 2003 After beginning his career as an architect in London Calvert Vaux 1824 1895 came to the Hudson River valley in 1850 at the invitation of Andrew Jackson Downing the reform minded writer on houses and gardens As Downing's partner and after Downing's death in 1852 Vaux designed country and suburban dwellings that were remarkable for their well conceived plans and their sensitive rapport with nature By 1857 the year he published his book Villas and Cottages Vaux had moved to New York City There he asked Frederick Law Olmsted to join him in preparing a design for Central Park He spent the next 38 years defending and refining their vision of Central Park as a work of art After the Civil War he and Olmsted led the nascent American park movement with their designs for parks and parkways in Brooklyn Buffalo and many other American cities Apart from undertakings with Olmsted Vaux cultivated a distinguished architectural practice Among his clients were the artist Frederic Church whose dream house Olana he helped create and the reform politician Samuel Tilden whose residence on New York's Gramercy Park remains one of the country's outstanding Victorian buildings A pioneering advocate for apartment houses in American cities Vaux designed buildings that mirrored the advance of urbanization in America including early model housing for the poor He planned the original portions of the Metropolitan Museum of Art and the American Museum of Natural History and conceived a stunning proposal for a vast iron and glass building to house the Centennial Exhibition in Philadelphia Especially notable are the many bridges and other charming structures that he designed for Central Park Vaux considered the Park's Terrace decorated by J W Mould as his greatest achievement An active participant in the cultural and intellectual life of New York Vaux was an idealist who regarded himself as an artist and a professional And while much has been written on Olmsted comparatively little has been published about Vaux The first in depth account of Vaux's career *Country Park and City* should be of great interest to historians of art architecture and urbanism as well as preservationists and other readers interested in New York City's past and America's first parks

influence writers and artists had upon urban residents especially the painters of the Hudson River School whose ideal landscapes created expectations about how rural America should appear By the mid 1800s urban residents had turned the Catskills into an important vacation ground and by the late 1800s the Catskills had become one of the premiere resort regions in the nation In the mid twentieth century the older Catskill resort region was in steep decline but the Jewish Borscht Belt in the southern Catskills was thriving The automobile revitalized mountain tourism and residence and increased the threat of suburbanization of the historic landscape Throughout each of these significant incarnations urban and rural residents worked in a rough collaboration though not without conflict to reshape the mountains and American ideas about rural landscapes and nature

The Papers of Frederick Law Olmsted Frederick Law Olmsted, 1977 The concluding volume of the monumental Papers of Frederick Law Olmsted captures some of Olmsted's greatest achievements Choice 2015 Outstanding Academic Title In 1890 Frederick Law Olmsted then nearly sixty eight years old had risen to the pinnacle of his career Together with his partners stepson John Charles Olmsted and protégé Henry Sargent Codman he was involved in a number of major ongoing projects including the Boston Buffalo and Rochester park systems the campus plan for Stanford University and numerous private estates In July he reported that the firm had twenty works of considerable importance underway including nine large parks and six estates that he believed were matters of public interest Before the summer ended the firm's commitments would expand dramatically as Olmsted and his partners were appointed landscape architects for the World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago As commissions for new park systems residential communities grounds for educational institutions and private homes increased Olmsted feared that their commitments would exceed the partners ability to do their best work Despite these fears Olmsted's work in the final six years of his professional career would only enhance his considerable reputation as the ninth and final volume of The Papers of Frederick Law Olmsted reveals With its impressive waterways monumental buildings and verdant islands and shores the Chicago fair proved to be one of the firm's crowning achievements The early 1890s also saw the culmination of Olmsted's wide ranging work on one of his other great projects the design of the grounds of George W Vanderbilt's massive estate Biltmore near Asheville North Carolina In planning the estate's thousands of acres Olmsted outlined new approaches to landscape design promoted the creation of the first scientific forestry operation in the United States designed a model residential subdivision and proposed an arboretum that would have been the most ambitious in the nation The Last Great Projects 1890 1895 chronicles the history of one of the world's greatest landscape design firms

while offering a fascinating retrospective on Frederick Law Olmsted's productive final years. The volume also gathers together the important documents of this last triumphant era. As Olmsted neared the end of his career he wrote some of his most reflective letters and reports summarizing the legacy of his involvement with the U.S. Sanitary Commission, the quality of landscape design in England and France, the biographical circumstances that proved most important to his development as an artist and his hopes and fears for the future of his profession. **Manhattan Phoenix** Daniel S. Levy, 2022 Shows vividly how the Great Fire of 1835 which nearly leveled Manhattan also created the ashes from which the city was reborn. In 1835 a merchant named Gabriel Disosway marveled at a great fire enveloping New York commenting on how it spread more and more vividly from the fiery arena rendering every object far and wide minutely discernible the lower bay and its Islands with the shores of Long Island and New Jersey. The fire Disosway witnessed devastated a large swath of lower Manhattan clearing roughly the same number of acres as the World Trade Center bombing. Manhattan Phoenix explores the emergence of modern New York after it emerged from the devastating fire of 1835 a catastrophe that revealed how truly unprepared and haphazardly organized it was to become a world class city merely a quarter of a century later. The one led to other New York effectively had to start over. Daniel Levy's book charts Manhattan's almost miraculous growth while interweaving the lives of various New Yorkers who took part in the city's transformation. Some are well known such as the land baron John Jacob Astor and Mayor Fernando Wood. Others less so as with the African American oysterman Thomas Downing and the Bowery Theatre impresario Thomas Hamblin. The book celebrates Fire Chief James Gulick who battled the blaze and celebrates the work of the architect Alexander Jackson Davis who built marble palaces for the rich. It chronicles the career of the merchant Alexander Stewart who constructed the first department store follows the struggles of the abolitionist Arthur Tappan and records of the efforts of the engineer John Bloomfield Jervis who brought clean water into homes. And this resurgence owed so much to the visionaries such as Frederick Law Olmsted and Calvert Vaux who designed Central Park creating a refuge that it remains to this day. Manhattan Phoenix reveals a city first in flames and then in flux but resolute in its determination to emerge as one of the world's greatest metropolises. **Sanctified Landscape** David Schuyler, 2012-04-06 The Hudson River Valley was the first iconic American landscape. Beginning as early as the 1820s artists and writers found new ways of thinking about the human relationship with the natural world along the Hudson. Here amid the most dramatic river and mountain scenery in the eastern United States Washington Irving and James Fenimore Cooper created a distinctly American literature grounded in folklore and history that contributed to the emergence of a sense of place in the valley. Painters led by Thomas Cole founded the Hudson River School widely recognized as the first truly national style of art. As the century advanced and as landscape and history became increasingly intertwined in the national consciousness an aesthetic identity took shape in the region through literature art memory and folklore even gardens and domestic architecture. Those who could afford to live some distance from jobs in the city built suburban homes or country estates. Given these momentous changes it is not surprising that historic preservation emerged in the Hudson Valley the first building in the United States preserved for its historic significance is Washington's Headquarters in Newburgh. Schuyler also finds the seeds of the modern environmental movement in the transformation of the Hudson Valley landscape. Richly illustrated and compellingly written *Sanctified Landscape* makes for rewarding reading. Schuyler expertly ties local history to national developments revealing why the Hudson River Valley was so important to nineteenth century Americans and why it is still beloved today.
