His study of the urban pastoral from Baudelaire through Eliot, Crane and Gwendolyn Brooks to Shepherd's own work provides a fresh view of the place of urban landscape in American poetry. Throughout his essays as in his poetry, Shepherd juxtaposes unabashed lyricism, historical awareness and in your face contemporaneity bristling with intelligence.
