Norman E. Saul, 2006 With Friends or Foes Norman Saul continues his monumental multivolume magnum opus on U.S. Russian relations over the course of 200 years This fourth volume provides the first comprehensive study in any language of

an era that shaped the rest of the century and captures the major changes in relations between two nations on the verge of becoming dominant global powers.
