Maestro,2023-08-21 Si no se sabe lo que es la ficción no se sabe lo que es la literatura Sin ficción no hay literatura y sin literatura la ficción queda limitada a una suerte de enunciado matemático para escolares parábola moralizante o grimorio religioso cuyos protagonistas son agentes de episodios que siendo imaginarios no son precisamente poéticos Son disciplinarios o preceptivos Tngase en cuenta que la literatura nace esencialmente porque construye con palabras con palabras poéticas hechos que jamás han tenido lugar tal y como se han contado con esas mismas palabras Hechos que sin embargo una vez contruidos verbalmente resultan imposibles de olvidar y soslayar Con hechos así se identifican las personas los pueblos las ideologías las sociedades bárbaras y las sociedades civilizadas las gentes de paz y hasta los más crueles asesinos La literatura se ha impuesto siempre por medio de la ficción Y siempre con consecuencias reales Porque la ficción en contra de lo que nos han enseñado no es algo dissociable de la realidad sino una parte esencial de ella No salimos de la realidad cuando leemos una novela o vivimos una obra de ficción Y ha sido la ficción la que ha permitido sortear censuras limitaciones interdicciones proscripciones e incluso patbulos Sólo en pocas de extrema intolerancia como la que actualmente atravesamos y vivimos sin querer reconocerlo la ficción se ha tomado legalmente en serio A veces hasta el punto de censurarla prohibirla o simplemente derogarla Lo políticamente correcto no entiende de ficciones Y aún menos entiende de literatura Como Platón su filosofía moral es muy otra y muy ajena a la ficción y a la literatura Sólo el tramposo se toma el juego en serio Pero el tramposo con excesiva frecuencia en la Historia dispone de más poderes que el poeta Y de mejores alianzas y amistades Las formas de enfrentarse a la ficción son sutiles y perversas Pero todas son insuficientes La única forma destruir la ficción es destruir al ser humano Siempre he dicho que el grado de libertad de una sociedad lo mide la literatura y no la religión ni la política ni tampoco la filosofía actividades estas tres que con frecuencia pactan su propia supervivencia a costa de la libertad humana a la que reprimen sin pudor y con fruición siempre que pueden Se ha dicho que Marx Nietzsche y Freud son los hermeneutas de la sospecha porque invitan a sospechar de la realidad Lo cierto es que la

obra de estos autores alberga las más sospechosas interpretaciones de la realidad con las que un ser humano puede toparse si nos atenemos cuando menos a la dimensión enormemente ficticia y tan pobremente literaria que desencadena toda su obra utópica a barbarie e irracionalismo. Negar el distintivo específico exclusivo y casi excluyente que la literatura posee sobre la ficción es el primer paso para hacer de la ficción algo ininteligible previo a su destierro político y a su exterminio político.
