Apart from typographical errors the revision was trifling.

The Fall of the House of Usher is a narrative short story by American writer Edgar Allan Poe first published in 1839 in Burton's *Gentleman's Magazine* before being included in the collection *Tales of the Grotesque and Arabesque* in 1840. The short story is a work of gothic fiction and includes themes of madness, family isolation and metaphysical identities. This is one of many books in the series *3 Books To Know*.
