Chapter 1

Genesis 1:1 "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth"

"It is no accident that God is the subject of the first sentence of the Bible. The passage, indeed the Book, is about Him first of all; to read it with any other primary interest (which is all too possible) is to misread it" (*Kidner p. 43*).

"In the beginning": This infers: (a) Prior to Genesis 1:1 nothing material existed. The whole physical creation owes its very existence to God (Acts 17:24-25). (b) God was already present 'in the beginning', i.e. He is eternal (John 1:1). (c) The material universe had a definite beginning. "That is, all of the other ancient religious books and religious systems, as well as all modern philosophies, begin, not with God, but with preexisting matter or energy in some form" (*Morris p. 38*).
