1. Understand the Format

Common Core report cards are typically divided into sections:

- Each subject is broken into specific units.
- Progress is usually marked as performance.
- Students are assigned to different levels:
 - Standard
 - Standard Exemplary
 - Exemplary Standard
 - Exemplary



2. Connect Measures Throughout the Reporting Period

- Use assessments, classroom observations, and samples to track student performance.
- Many observations or situations to make teacher to make note.

3. Assess State Standard

- For each standard based on the report card, identify mastery based on the identified standard.
- Identify strengths. These are based on mastery.

4. Audit Standards

- Use the common version of Kindergarten as a benchmark for development.

5. Report to Parents

- Identify the numbers from:
 - How they can support learning at home.
 - How they can support learning at school.
