A native of El Salvador, Dr. Luna is particularly interested in the transnationalism linkages created by the Latino Community in the United States and in their home countries. He is a frequent guest lecturer and presents regularly at conferences on issues of transnationalism and the Latino presence in America. In spring 2010, he was awarded the Outstanding Undergraduate Advisor Award for excellence in service to the College of Behavioral and Social Science and the Department of Geographical Sciences.
