Van Dyke, a cultivated art historian, saw sublimity in the desert's lonely desolation, which previous generations had perceived only as a wasteland. His book has a conservationist flavor which seems distinctly modern. The deserts should never be reclaimed, he writes. They are the breathing spaces of the west and should be preserved for ever. The changing colors of the sky, hills, and sand impress Van Dyke as do the mirages. He celebrates the long overlooked commonplace things of nature: cactus and grease wood, desert animals and winged life, the birds and insects. His writing has a philosophical undertone. Not in vain these wastes of sand simply because they are beautiful in themselves and good to look upon, whether they be life or death.
