The two try to escape via Byfleet just after dawn but are separated at the Shepperton to Weybridge Ferry during a Martian afternoon attack on Shepperton. One of the Martian fighting machines is brought down in the River Thames by artillery as the narrator and countless others try to cross the river into Middlesex as the Martians retreat back to their original crater. This gives the authorities precious hours to form a defence line covering London. After the Martians' temporary repulse, the narrator is able to float down the Thames in a boat toward London, stopping at Walton where he first encounters the curate, his companion for the coming weeks.
