Encryption of 'data-at-rest'

- Goal
 - Protect against theft or loss of a system in transit
 - Protect against theft or loss of physical storage media (disk subsystem or array)
 - Allow failed drives to be returned-to-factory securely
 - Provide adequate data encryption security to meet basic compliance regulations
- DD Encryption
 - Encrypts all system data at rest in the physical storage
 - Provides adequate encryption key management to ensure key integrity and security
 - **Note:** not supported on systems with DD Extended Retention
