The set is the interior of a modern three-bedroom bungalow, 406 Clybourne Street, in the near northwest of central Chicago. There is a sitting room with four door access, a fireplace with an oak mantelpiece, and a separate dining area with built-in cupboards. At the rear of the dining area, a swinging door leads to a kitchen. A staircase leads up to a second floor, and beneath it, another door leads down to a basement. There is a hallway and a bathroom down as well.

NOTE:

In the original production, the actor playing Jim and Tom also played the role of Kurnack. In some subsequent productions a separate actor was hired to play the role of Kurnack alone.

CLYBOURNE PARK

ACT ONE

September 1959. Three o'clock, Saturday afternoon. The house is in disorder. Cardboard boxes are stacked in corners. Some furniture has been removed, shelves emptied. Pictures have been removed from the walls and corners have been filled and stored in end. Not far from the fireplace, Russ sits alone reading a copy of National Geographic. He is dressed in pajama top and bottoms, socks, no shoes. On a table next to him sits a carton of ice cream bars which, from time to time, he dips in syrup. Inastic plays softly on a radio next to him.

After some time, Rev. descends the stairs carrying dinner to place on a cardbord box. As she goes, she sings to Russ.

REV. You're not going to eat all of that, are you? (He turns down the radio.)

RUSS. (With his mouth full.) What'dya say?

REV. What ice cream is that?

RUSS. Um. (Looks at the carton.) Neapolitan.

REV. Well, don't feel compelled to eat that.

RUSS. (Strong, barely audible.) Going to write. (He turns the radio back up and Francine comes from the kitchen, wearing a maid's uniform. She remains in the foreground as Rev. joins her.)

FRANCINE. (To Rev.) See, if it's all right I'm just going to put these candlesticks here in the big box with the towels.

REV. That is what I would do, yes, but you do need to wrap them first.

FRANCINE. Oh, you endam.

REV. (Oh.) Now. Francine, I was wondering about this chafing dish, which we have practically never used.

FRANCINE. Yes, ma'am.

REV. Do you own one of these yourself?

FRANCINE. No, I sure don't.

REV. Because I do love to entertain though for the life of me I can't remember the last time we did. But still, it does seem a shame to give it away because it's just such a nice thing, isn't it?

FRANCINE. Oh, yes it is.

REV. And it just looks so lonely sitting there in the cupboard so I was wondering if this might be the sort of thing that would be useful to you?

FRANCINE. Ohhhh, thank you, I couldn't take that.

REV. (On chafing dish.) See how well it looks?

FRANCINE. You don't want to be giving that to me.

REV. Well, notwithstanding I'm offering.

FRANCINE. No, I don't think I should.

REV. Well, you think about it.

FRANCINE. But thank you for offering.

REV. You think about it and let me know.

FRANCINE. Yes, ma'am.

REV. And do you have some paper around there.

FRANCINE. Yes, ma'am. (Francine goes into kitchen. Rev. turns back over to pack, passing Russ.)

REV. That's a funny word, isn't it? Neapolitan.

RUSS. (Takes off radio.) Funny what way?

REV. What do you suppose is the origin of that?

RUSS. Uh-huh ... Naples, I imagine.

REV. Naples.

RUSS. City of Naples.

REV. Naples.

RUSS. Uh-huh.

REV. Because a person from Naples, I mean they wouldn't be called, well, not Neapolitan, obviously. I guess that was clearly ruled. (Laughs, then serious.) On the other hand, you also say Belgian. Belgium, though, and specifically ones that end in S, because there must be a rule of some sort, don't you think? Help me think of a city other than Naples that also ends in S? (Pauses.)

RUSS. Uh-huh —

REV. Oh, Sodje. Um.

RUSS. Dex Moiders.

REV. Not a silver S.

RUSS. Brussels.

REV. All right. There you go. And how do we refer to them?

RUSS. Belgians.

REV. But, the people from the city.

RUSS. Never ever anyone from Brussels.

REV. But there has to be a word.

RUSS. Look it up.

REV. Where?

RUSS. Dictionary?

REV. But it's not going to say this is the capital of Belgium and by the way the people who live there are called —

RUSS. Give Selly a call.

REV. She won't know that.

RUSS. She and Ray went to Paris.

REV. So?

RUSS. Close to Brussels.

REV. Selly never knows those sorts of things.

RUSS. Oh, Oh.

REV. What?

RUSS. Parisian.

REV. What about that? (Francine returns with more packing.)

REV. Uh-huh.
