Case Study Research for Students

Overview

Good academic performance is attributed to both the student's learning capabilities and privilege. Normally, when there are too many distractions, such as economic barriers and family conflicts, learning is only conducive in school, or worse, they only happen on good days.

Statement of the Problem

Adverse Childhood Experiences or ACEs have a profound impact on academic performance. Students who are victims of abuse at home find it difficult to concentrate on studying because their self-worth is low and they may have already acquired chemical imbalances that make concentration difficult. As such, it is important to know how to encourage students with many ACEs to study despite their situations and difficulties.

Methodology

The present research conducted a survey among students with varying degrees of ACEs to obtain insight into how they preferred to learn. A sample size of 30 students was made to take a personality test that determined their learning preferences. The survey also included a short background check on what extent of ACEs the respondents underwent.

Results and Discussion

A majority of the respondents or 94% proposed they must be given deadline considerations for homework, because, according to them, their situations at home discouraged them from finishing their tasks on time. Most of the respondents come from abusive families with prominent alcoholism in the household, so they always need to manage and resolve family conflicts first before doing academic requirements.

Conclusion

All students differ, not just in their capabilities, but in the nature of their roots. As such, schools must always be considerate of every student's situation and develop equitable and appropriate mechanisms to still help them learn, despite their difficulties.
