Nursing Case Study

I. Health History

The subject of my case study is W. R. W.R. is a 75 year old white male who was admitted to Mercy Care Hospital on November 21, 2012. Prior to being admitted to the hospital, Mr. R. had been in excellent health. His condition apparently began three weeks prior to being admitted. On November 21, W. R. 's son found him lying on the floor motionless and unable to move.

Mr. R. was diagnosed as having an acute cerebral vascular accident. This disorder can also be described as a "stroke". It occurs when there is an interruption of normal blood flow to one or more of the blood vessels that supply the brain. Thrombosis, embolism, and hemorrhage are the primary causes of a CVA. (Flemmons and Johnson 2002) The causes of the brain damage include; leading to hypoxia or trauma with destruction or damage of the neurons, glia, and vasculature. Complications of CVA include; unstable blood pressure, memory and motor impairment, infections, pneumonia, constipation, and pulmonary edema. CVA is the third leading cause of death in the United States and affects over 500,000 Americans annually. (Flemmons and Johnson 2002).

He was admitted to October of 2011, one daughter has coronary artery disease, one son died of an MI at age 57, and one son died with lung cancer at 57. He had been the primary care giver of his daughter until she was admitted to the hospital three weeks ago. She is dying with a chronic bowel syndrome and confusion and is now being taken care of in hospice. Since after being left alone, Mr. R.'s appetite decreased and he had become confused. He was placed on Zoloft to treat symptoms of depression. He had also been taking Opan to repress. After his family noticed that he was suffering from confusion. As a result, they brought him into the Emergency Room for evaluation. The Emergency Room doctors
