They identified a particular risk in the Government's decision to split the delivery of probation services between a public National Probation Service dealing with the highest risk offenders and the new providers who will be dealing with low and medium risk offenders. At this stage, with the plans already beginning to come into effect, it is for the Government to look carefully at the areas where either risk or a need for clarification has been identified.
