**States of Matter** Matter can exist in three primary states: solid, liquid, and gas. In each state, the particles are arranged differently. In a solid, the particles are packed closely together. In a liquid, the particles are more spread out. In a gas, the particles are very far apart. In a plasma, the particles are even more spread out. In a Bose-Einstein condensate, the particles are very close together, but they have different properties from the other states of matter.

**Changes of State** Matter can change from one state to another. This is called a change of state. There are four main changes of state: melting, freezing, evaporation, and condensation. Melting is when a solid turns into a liquid. Freezing is when a liquid turns into a solid. Evaporation is when a liquid turns into a gas. Condensation is when a gas turns into a liquid.
