Mitchell, 1994 Although the theory of object oriented programming languages is far from complete this book brings together the most important contributions to its development to date focusing in particular on how advances in type systems and semantic models can contribute to new language designs The fifteen chapters are divided into five parts Objects and Subtypes Type Inference Coherence Record Calculi and Inheritance The chapters are organized approximately in order of increasing complexity of the programming language constructs they consider beginning with variations on Pascal and Algol like languages developing the theory of illustrative record object models and concluding with research directions for building a more comprehensive theory of object oriented programming
