METAPHASE

For asexual reproduction:

The chromosomes are now free in the cytoplasm. Each centrosome has formed a spindle. Microtubules collectively known as the spindle. The chromosomes line up along the middle of the cell and split.

TELOPHASE

When the chromosomes reach the cell, they begin to spiral longer and thinner. A nuclear cell forms around each group, and the cytoplasm will all the process of cytokinesis.

Meiosis is a process of cell division that produces four daughter cells.

Meiosis plays an important role in sexual reproduction, as it produces gametes (the human cell) to ensure it produces sperm and it produces eggs. This occurs in the reproductive system. These cells are different from ordinary cells, because they have lost the number of chromosomes (a cell has the haploid number). When gametes fuse at the process of fertilization, the resulting cell has a full diploid cell.
