tool must be infinitely flexible which MongoDB is At the same time this flexibility does come with a small learning curve and that is why this book exists We aim to provide people with a great way to look at many of the core storage features of MongoDB To do this we have eschewed some of the more complex operational features such as Sharding and Replication we also avoided going into depth with a lot of the operations level mechanics
